- Test on target devices — If targeting mobile or embedded platforms, validate SDKs or edge

runtimes for performance and battery/size constraints before committing.

Confirm which SDKs are supported, the available hosting options, and the expected latency for your target platform.

Seek recent user feedback about reliability, costs, and support responsiveness.
